It represents a lasting commitment to preserving wisdom, honouring heritage, promoting ethical traditional practice, and serving humanity with humility and compassion.

CHAPTER TWELVE

OBOADE ROYAL TEMPLE represents the organisational structure that provides governance, administration, and long-term support for that mission.

Together they serve one purpose: preserving African Traditional Spirituality, honouring cultural heritage, promoting ethical traditional practice, and serving humanity with integrity and compassion.

An important milestone in this journey came in November 2025, when the organisation was formally registered, providing an official legal foundation for its future development.

Another significant step followed in March 2026, when the Registrar of Companies approved the organisation's change of name to **OBOADE ROYAL TEMPLE**, reflecting the broader vision, expanded mission, and long-term purpose of the institution.

Following this approval, the organisation received its official Certificate of Incorporation of a Company, confirming its legal recognition as:

OBOADE ROYAL TEMPLE LBG

Registration Number: **CG080291125**

The certificate states:

"I hereby certify that **OBOADE ROYAL TEMPLE LBG** has been incorporated as a company under the laws of the Republic of Ghana."

This official incorporation represented a significant milestone in the development of the mission. It established a recognised organisational foundation through which the vision of **GYENYAME SUNSUM KESE TEMPLE** could continue to grow with proper structure, accountability, and responsible leadership.

The incorporation of **OBOADE ROYAL TEMPLE LBG** strengthened the relationship between the spiritual mission of **GYENYAME SUNSUM KESE TEMPLE** and the organisational framework required to support its future development.

Through this legal foundation, the institution is positioned to pursue its objectives in the areas of spiritual service, cultural preservation, traditional knowledge, community development, and initiatives that honour and protect African heritage for present and future generations.

This achievement represents not only an administrative accomplishment but also a confirmation of the importance of building a lasting institution supported by both spiritual commitment and responsible organisational practice.

During this same period, another important milestone was achieved. On 4 March 2026, **GYENYAME SUNSUM KESE TEMPLE** was officially registered as a Herbal Center in accordance with the Traditional Medicine Practice Act, 2000 (Act 575) of the Republic of Ghana.

The official licence states:

“This is to certify that **GYENYAME SUNSUM KESE TEMPLE** has been registered as a Herbal Center, in compliance with the Traditional Medicine Practice Act, 2000 (Act 575), with the rights, privileges and honours thereto appertaining.”

This licence, issued on 4 March 2026, represented an important milestone in the Temple’s history. It affirmed the Temple’s commitment to operating within Ghana’s legal framework for traditional medicine while promoting responsible, ethical, and professional traditional herbal practice. It also strengthened the Temple’s mission to preserve African Traditional knowledge and provide traditional wellness services with integrity, respect, and accountability.

These milestones represented far more than administrative achievements. They reflected the steady growth of a vision that had expanded from one person’s spiritual journey into an institution committed to serving communities, preserving heritage, and supporting future generations.

Today, **OBOADE ROYAL TEMPLE** continues to provide the organisational foundation that supports **GYENYAME SUNSUM KESE TEMPLE**, ensuring that its mission is guided by responsible leadership, cultural preservation, ethical service, community development, and faithful stewardship.

Looking back upon this journey, I remain grateful to the Supreme Creator for every step from the first revelations of my childhood to the establishment of institutions dedicated to preserving African Traditional Spirituality and serving humanity with wisdom, humility, compassion, and integrity.

With this organisational foundation established, the next stage of the journey was to define clearly the spiritual beliefs, guiding principles, mission, vision, and values that would shape **GYENYAME SUNSUM KESE TEMPLE** for generations to come.

CHAPTER THIRTEEN
